


Project

We are learning about Winter Wonderland !

** Explore shapes in the environment and use informal mathematical vocabulary to talk about the shape of everyday objects, such as round and tall.*

**Link numerals and amounts, showing the right number of fingers or objects to match numerals up to five.*

**Use and understand language of quantities, such as more and a lot.*
