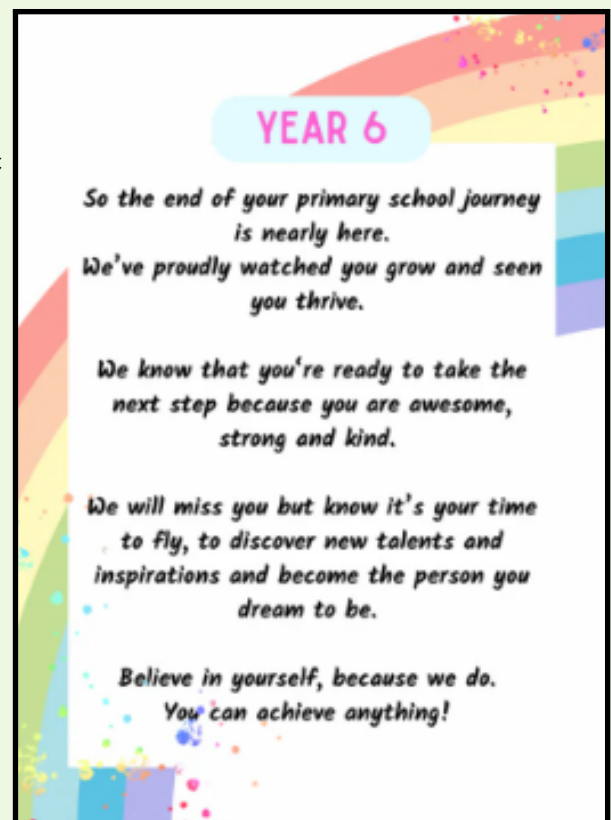
I do hope you all have a wonderful Summer holidays and manage to rest, enjoy the sunshine (when it comes) and have some down time. I am always here if you need me at any point

We have just put an advert out for someone to join our team. The role is based in Wheel Harmony for mornings (8:30 - 12:30pm).



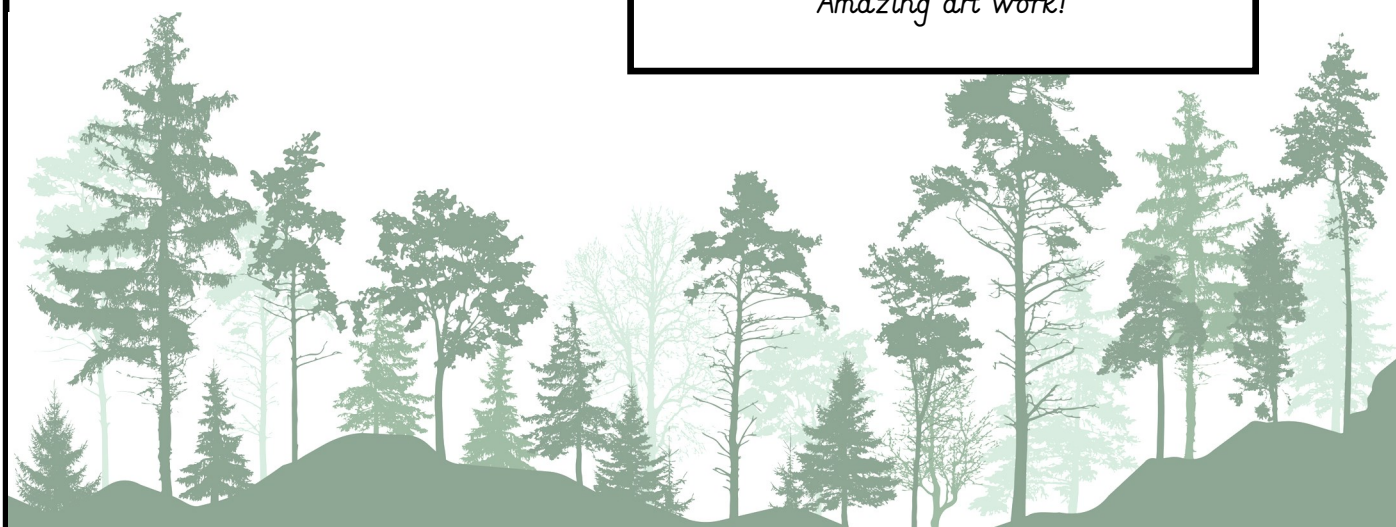
