Paper Plate Jellyfish


You will need:

- Paper Plate
- Washable Kid Friendly Paint
- Glitter Shaker Pots
- Ribbon
- Felt
- **PVA Glue**
- Scissors
- Stapler

Tutorial:

- 1. To begin you will need your paper plate and some paint, and parents, take a BIG step back.
- 2. Once they're finished decorating their paper plates, offer a little glitter to add some seaside shimmer. If you don't have any glitter or would prefer not to use glitter – as it's not everyone's cup of tea, try adding some shiny sequins and embellishments instead.
- 3. Trim the paper plate to a 'jellyfish' shape and then turn the paper plate over.
- 4. Cover the freshly cut edge with a generous amount of PVA Glue.
- 5. Cut a number of strands of ribbon to various lengths.
- 6. Add the ribbon to the paper plate, ensuring they're nicely spaced out.
- 7. Cut out a pair of white and black circles to create eyes and add them to the jellyfish.
- 8. Finish of with a hanging hook using a small piece of ribbon and secure with a staple.





Delicious Dessert!

Here's an easy 3 ingredient recipe to make some delicious. gooey Malteser bars! With zero baking required it's the perfect treat to make with all the family!

Ingredients

- 400g Milk Chocolate
- 400-500g Maltesers
- 1 Can of condensed milk

Method

- 1. Melt the chocolate in a large bowl.
- 2. Add the condensed milk and mix quickly as the mixture will cool fast!
- 3. Add 3 quarters of the maltesers into the mixture and pour into a square tin.
- 4. Spread the mixture so it is roughly 3/4cm thick.
- 5. Sprinkle the remaining Maltesers over the top
- 6. Leave in the fridge overnight to cool
- 7. Cut into portions and enjoy!

Crunchy Cookies!

Ingredients

- 225g Butter, softened
- 110g Caster sugar
- 275g Plain flour
- 74g White or milk chocolate chips

Method

- 1. Heat your oven to 190C/170C Fan/ Gas 5. Cream the butter in a large bowl with a wooden spoon of food mixer until it is soft.
- 2. Add the sugar and keep beating until the mixture is light and fluffy.
- 3. Sift in the flour and add the chocolate chips. Bring the mixture together with your hands in a figure of eight motion until it forms a dough.
- 4. Roll the dough into walnut sized balls and place them slightly apart from each-other on a baking sheet.
- 5. Flatten the balls a little with the palm of your hand and bake them in the over for around 10-12 mins until they are golden brown and slightly firm on top.
- 6. Leave the cookies on a cooling rack for around 15 minutes before serving.











Science in your own home

Ocean Slime!

What You Need:

- 1/2 Cup Clear washable glue
- 1/4 Cup Liquid starch
- 1/2 Cup of water
- Food Colouring (Blue)
- Glitter
- Seashells (Optional)

What You Do:

- 1. In a bowl mix 1/2 cup water and 1/2 cup of glue (mix well to combine completely).
- 2. Now's the time to add (color, glitter, or confetti)! Remember when you add color to white glue, the color will be lighter. Use clear glue for jewel toned colors! You can never add too much glitter! Mix the glitter and food coloring into the glue and water mixture.
- 3. Pour in 1/4 cup of liquid starch. You will see the slime immediately start to form. Keep stirring until you have a gooey blob of slime. The liquid should be gone!
- 4. Start kneading your slime! It will appear stringy at first but just work it around with your hands and you will notice the consistency changes. You can also put it in a clean container and set it aside for 3 minutes, and you will also notice the change in consistency!

SLIME MAKING TIP: We always recommend kneading your slime well after mixing. Kneading the slime really helps to improve it's consistency. The trick with liquid starch slime is to put a few drops of the liquid starch onto your hands before picking up the slime.








Did you know...
