








Vocabulary

Large, heavy guns used on land. **Artillery**

The first steam by John sides to stop fighting. **Armistice**

Central Powers The central powers included Germany, Austria-Hungary, the Ottoman

Empire and Bulgaria.

A group of countries ruled by a single person, government or country. **Empire**

Enlist To join the army.

Units in the British Army that grouped men who were friends and had **PALs Battalions**

enlisted together.

Information used and shared to present one side of an argument. **Propaganda**

The process of encouraging people to join the army. Recruitment An alliance between a Britain, France and Russia. **Triple Entente**

Treaty of Versailles The treaty between the Allies and Germany that ended the War.
