Sequence of learning:	 To introduce the aim of the unit 'Les Salutations'. In this lesson, pupils will be introduced to some very basic language to allow for a simple, short exchange in French. How to say 'hello' and 'my name is' in French. Consolidate the words in French for 'hello' and 'my name is' in French before learning how to ask somebody how they are feeling in 	1- To introduce the unit 'Les Saisons'. In this lesson pupils will learn how to name (with accurate pronunciation) and remember the four seasons in French with the correct article/determiner. 2- In this lesson pupils will learn about what happens in winter and will also learn how to say a short sentence about this season in French. 3- In this lesson pupils will learn all about what happens in spring and	 Introduce new topic, storytelling in French using Petit Chaperon Rouge. To listen to the story again and use word cards and picture cards together to help remember vocabulary. To read the story again but with a focus to learn parts of the body in French.
